

Directions for making a wreath on the Wreathmaster

1. To begin, take the single rail clamp ring and push the clip it snugly into the jaws. (If the clip does not fit snugly, then the jaws need to be adjusted. Instructions on how to adjust the jaws are outlined in “Mounting Instructions” – Step 6).
2. Take a handful (approximately 10 – 15 tips, depending on how heavy you want the wreath to be) – and place the greens into the clamp; extending the cut ends approximately 2/3 of the way to the next clip.
3. Now, take both hands and place on either side of the jaws, slightly away from the top head, and push the greens down and hold them in place until the foot pedal has been depressed to the floor and the clamping on the ring is complete (i.e., the top head has come down and bent the clips tightening the greens).
4. Move the ring to the next open clip and proceed with Steps 1-3.
5. To complete the last clamp on the ring, you will need to lift the greens that are covering the empty clip. Continue holding them up as you place a handful of greens into the last clip and clamp them securely. Then release the greens that you have been holding up and fan them out. Blend the greens so there will be no sign of where the wreath was finished.
